

The Nazis Go To New Extremes

The wave of anti-Semitism unleashed in Germany following the assassination of a Nazi official in Paris by a young Jew explains why there have been so few attacks against the Nazis. The assassination provided a convenient excuse for Nazi terrorists to begin a wave of vicious attacks that mark a new extreme.

The young man who killed the German official was deranged by the treatment of Polish Jews in Germany recently. The Nazis and Nazi officials have treated the single act of violence as if it marked a wholesale attack on the part of all Jews. In a position to "avenge" the assassinated official, they have taken advantage of the helplessness of those who are held as virtual hostages in Germany.
